Jeff Fenholt was the main attraction for the night along with a Christian rock band (old rock). The Billing for Jeff Fenholt was "Jeff Fenholt has a miraculous testimony of the mercy and saving power of God. He grew up in an abusive family and turned to drugs and violence at a young age. The combination of his awesome vocal abilities and his lifestyle of drugs and violence led him into the world of heavy metal rock. He starred in the original Broadway show of Jesus Christ Superstar as the lead role—Jesus, and a vocalist for the rock group Black Sabbath. After his miraculous salvation and transformation, Jeff's life was turned around and he began reaching out to others who faced the same challenges he faced. He has appeared regularly on TBN and had his own weekly TV show there as well. He has an anointed music ministry, with a vocal style that can handle a wide range of music styles from opera to rock and roll. His desire is to reach the lost and to edify the Body of Christ." It was this billing that caught my eye, especially the part of where he was a vocalist for the group Black Sabbath. Back in 1970 and 1971 I was a big Black Sabbath fan and if my memory serves me right it was in 1971 when I attended one of their concerts and had seats on the first row next to the stage.
